



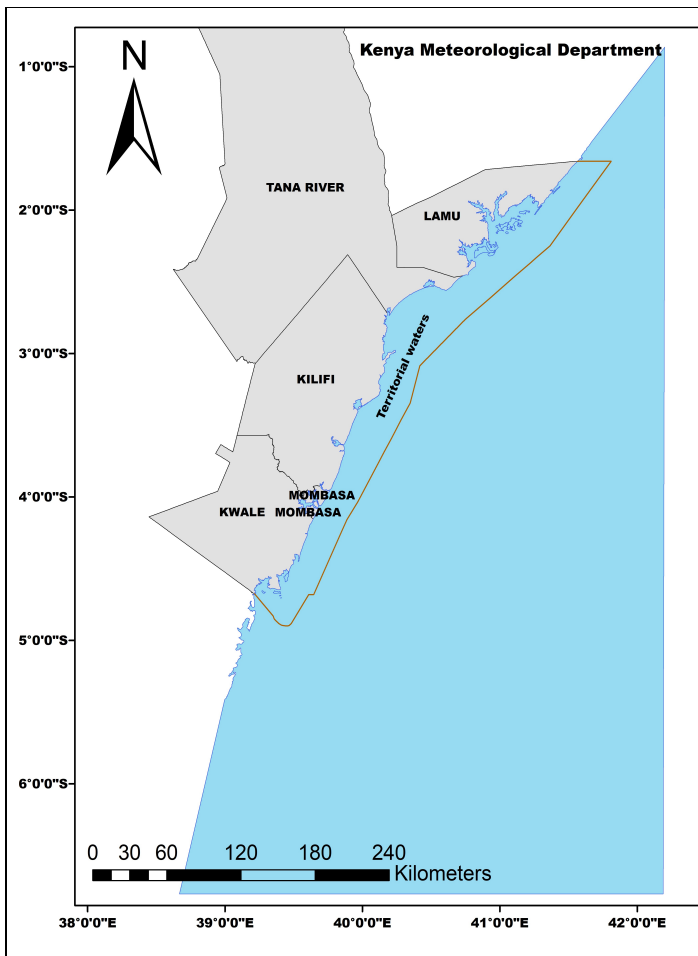

**GENERAL OUTLOOK**

**Morning sea state:**

- Light and variable winds (03-08 knots) with slight choppy seas. ESE waves of 3 feet (0.9m) with small period waves of (9 sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

**Afternoon sea state:**

- Light E to SE winds (07-15 knots) with slight choppy seas. ESE waves of 3 feet (0.9m) with small period waves of (10 sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

**Visibility:**

- Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

## **COASTAL COUNTIES MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST**

### **i. KWALE**

- Morning Winds: N 7 to 8 knots.
- Morning Waves: ENE 3 feet at 9 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light N winds with a slight chop. Very small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: NE 13 to 14 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 3 feet at 9 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy NE winds with moderate choppy seas. Small short period waves.
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10 km)
- High Tide: **01:17AM; 3.3m, 01:45PM; 2.8m**
- Low Tide: **07:45AM;0.8m, 07:40PM;0.7m**

### **ii. MOMBASA**

- Morning Winds: N 4 to 5 knots.

- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Very small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: ENE 9 to 11 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: E 3 feet at 9 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Light ENE winds with a slight chop. Very small short period waves.
- Sunrise; **5:57AM** and sunset; **6:17PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10 km)**
- High Tide: **01:19AM; 3.2m, 01:51PM; 2.6m**
- Low Tide: **07:49AM; 0.7m, 07:38PM;0.7m**

### **iii. KILIFI**

- Morning Winds: N 3 knots.
- Morning Waves: E 3 feet at 9 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: ENE 7 to 11 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: E 3 feet at 9 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Light ENE winds with a slight chop. Small short period waves.
- Sunrise; **5:57AM** and sunset; **6:15PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **01:06AM; 2.9m, 01:41PM;2.4m**
- Low Tide; **07:40AM; 0.6m, 07:29PM;0.7m**

### **iv. LAMU**

- Morning Winds: ENE 3 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 3 feet at 9 seconds
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Very small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: E 8 to 15 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 3 feet at 8 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Light E winds with a slight chop. Small short period waves.
- Sunrise; **5:55AM** and sunset; **6:10PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **01:06 AM; 2.8m, 01:41 PM;2.2m**
- Low Tide: **07:43 AM; 0.6m, 07:28 PM;0.6m**

### Advisory

- Slight sea conditions are expected with a significant wave height of 0.9m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
- Light to gentle breeze of (03-15 knots) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

4.1 – 5.5 m (≈ 12.3 – 16.5 ft)	Very Rough	Warning in place and marine activities on hold

#### KEY ON SEA STATE

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	< 1 – 7 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7 – 17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 – ≥34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!
