

#### **GENERAL OUTLOOK**

# Morning sea state:

Light to breezy NW to NE winds (03-13knots) with slight to moderate choppy seas. E to ENE waves of 4-6ft (1.2-1.8m) with small period waves of (8sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

#### Afternoon sea state:

Breezy E to ENE winds (11-21knots) with moderate choppy seas. ENE to E waves of 4-6eet (1.2-1.8m) with small period waves of (6-8sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

#### Visibility:

 Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

### **COASTAL COUNTIES MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST**

#### i. KWALE

- Morning Winds: NW 6 to 8 knots.
- Morning Waves: ENE 4 feet at 8 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light NW winds with a slight chop. Small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: ENE 12 to 15 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 4 feet at 9 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy ENE winds with moderate choppy seas. Small short period waves.
- Sunrise; 6.21AM and sunset; 6:43PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10 km)
- High Tide: 5:35AM; 3.68m, 6:02PM; 3.18m
  Low Tide: 11:55AM; 0.28m, 11:55PM; 0.53m

#### ii. MOMBASA

- Morning Winds: NNW 5 to 7 knots.
- Morning Waves: ENE 5 feet at 8 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: ENE 11 to 12 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 4 feet at 9 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy ENE winds with moderate choppy seas. Small short period waves.
- Sunrise; 6:21AM and sunset; 6:41PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10 km)
- High Tide: 5:41AM; 3.56m, 6:09PM; 3.13m
- Low Tide: 11:58AM; 0.31m, 11:59PM;0.56m

#### iii. KILIFI

- Morning Winds: NE 12 to 13 knots.
- Morning Waves: ENE 6 feet at 8 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Breezy NE winds with moderate choppy seas. Moderate short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: ENE 12 to 13 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 5 feet at 8 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy ENE winds with moderate choppy seas. Small short period waves.
- Sunrise; 6.20AM and sunset; 6:39PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10km)
- High Tide: 5:32AM; 3.28m, 6:00PM;2.85m
- Low Tide: 11:51AM; 0.11m, 11:52PM;0.39m

#### iv. <u>LAMU</u>

- Morning Winds: ENE 3 to 8 knots.
- Morning Waves: E 5 feet at 8 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: E 11 to 21 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: E 6 feet at 6 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy E winds with moderate choppy seas. Moderate very short period waves.
- Sunrise; 6:19AM and Sunset; 6:33PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10km)
- High Tide: 5:31AM; 3.16m, 6:01PM;2.71m
- Low Tide: 11:53AM; 0.1m, 11:52PM;0.38m

# Advisory

- Slight to moderate sea conditions are expected with a significant wave height of 1.2-1.8m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
- Light to fresh breeze of (03-21knots) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu throughout the forecast period. Small boats and crafts are advised to be cautious while venturing into deep sea in Lamu in the afternoon.

	<1-7 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7-17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 - ≥34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!!
