DAILY WEATHER FORECAST

Issued on 6th February 2025 at 3.00 P.M.

Validity: from 9.00 pm tonight to 9.00 pm tomorrow 7th February 2025.

PART I: WEATHER OUTLOOK ACROSS THE COUNTRY

Dry weather conditions expected over most parts of the country. However, light showers expected of the southwestern portion of the country. Strong south easterly winds of 25 knots (12.5 m/s) and above expected over parts of Northwestern and Northeastern region.

THE HIGHLANDS WEST OF THE RIFT VALLEY, THE LAKE VICTORIA BASIN, AND THE RIFT VALLEY

These counties include: KAKAMEGA, VIHIGA, BUSIA, BUNGOMA, KISUMU, KISII, NYAMIRA, MIGORI, SIAYA, HOMABAY, KERICHO, NANDI, BOMET, NAKURU, ELGEYO MARAKWET, WEST POKOT, BARINGO, UASIN GISHU, TRANS-NZOIA and NAROK).

Showers and thunderstorms over few places expected tonight. Sunny intervals expected to prevail the whole day tomorrow. However, there is a chance of showers over few places in the afternoon around Narok and Migori.

HIGHLANDS EAST OF THE RIFT VALLEY (INCLUDING NAIROBI COUNTY)

(These counties include: NYERI, MURANGA, KIRINYAGA, EMBU, MERU, KIAMBU, THARAKA NITHI, LAIKIPIA, NYANDARUA and NAIROBI).

Partly cloudy conditions expected tonight. Cloudy conditions expected in the morning breaking into sunny intervals the rest of the day.

NORTH WESTERN

(These counties include TURKANA and SAMBURU).

Partly cloudy conditions expected tonight. Sunny intervals expected to prevail the whole day tomorrow.

Strong southeasterly winds of 25 knots (12.5 m/s) and above expected over Turkana County.

NORTH EASTERN

(These counties include MARSABIT, GARISSA, MANDERA, WAJIR, and ISIOLO).

Partly cloudy conditions expected tonight. Sunny intervals expected to prevail the entire day tomorrow.

Strong easterly component winds of 25 knots (12.5 m/s) and above expected over Marsabit County.

SOUTH EASTERN LOWLANDS

(These counties include: MACHAKOS, MAKUENI, KITUI, TAITA TAVETA, and KAJIADO).

Partly cloudy conditions expected tonight. Sunny intervals expected to prevail the whole day tomorrow.

COAST

(These counties include: KWALE, MOMBASA, KILIFI, LAMU, and TANA RIVER).

Partly cloudy conditions expected tonight. Sunny intervals expected to prevail the entire day tomorrow.
