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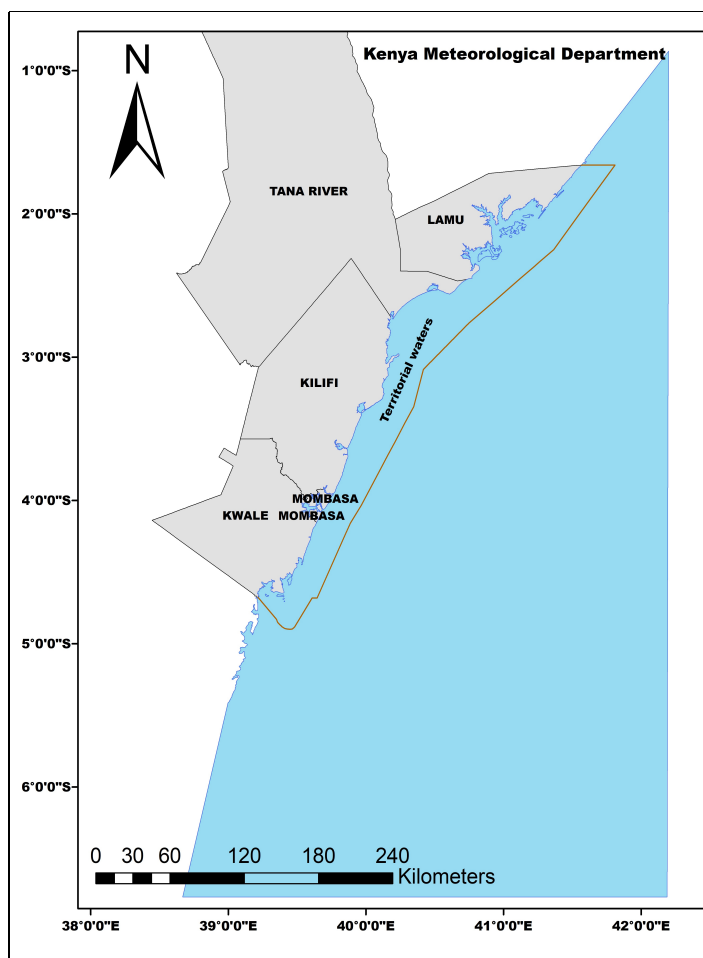
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DAILY MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST FOR KENYAN COAST

Issued at: 1500 EAT on 6th February, 2025

Valid: 0000 EAT on 7th February 2025 to 0000 EAT on 8th February 2025



GENERAL OUTLOOK

Morning sea state:

- Light and variable winds (06-16 knots) with slight choppy seas. ESE waves of 4-5 feet (1.2m -1.5m) with small period waves of (8 sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Afternoon sea state:

- Light E to SE winds (13-19 knots) with slight choppy seas. ESE waves of 3-4 feet (1.2m-1.5m) with small period waves of (8 sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Visibility:

- Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

COASTAL COUNTIES MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST

i. KWALE

- Morning Winds: NNE 11 to 12 knots.
- Morning Waves: ENE 5 feet at 8 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Breezy NNE winds with moderate choppy seas. Small short period waves..
- Afternoon Winds: E 13 to 17 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: NE 4 feet at 8 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy E winds with moderate choppy seas. Small short period waves.
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10 km)
- High Tide: **11:28 AM; 2.2m,**
- Low Tide: **05:16 AM; 1.4m, 05:05 PM;1.4m**

ii. MOMBASA

- Morning Winds: NNE 6 to 7 knots.
- Morning Waves: ENE 4 feet at 7 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light NNE winds with a slight chop. Small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: E 14 to 16 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 4 feet at 9 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy E winds with moderate choppy seas. Small short period waves.
- Sunrise; **5:57AM** and sunset; **6:17PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10 km)**
- High Tide: **11:19AM; 2.1m,**
- Low Tide: **05:23AM; 1.3m, 04:59PM; 1.3m**

iii. KILIFI

- Morning Winds: NE 9 knots.
- Morning Waves: ENE 5 feet at 7 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light NE winds with a slight chop. Moderate short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: E 15 to 17 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 4 feet at 9 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Moderate to strong E winds with choppy seas. Small short period waves.
- Sunrise; **5:57AM** and sunset; **6:15PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **11:14AM; 1.8m,**
- Low Tide; **05:20AM; 1.1m, 04:53PM;1.1m**

iv. LAMU

- Morning Winds: ENE 10 to 16 knots.
- Morning Waves: E 4 feet at 6 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Breezy ENE winds with moderate choppy seas. Small very short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: E 15 to 19 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: E 3 feet at 9 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Moderate to strong E winds with choppy seas. Small short period waves.
- Sunrise; **00:38AM** and sunset; **6:10PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **11:11; 1.7m,**
- Low Tide: **05:24 AM; 1.1m, 04:51 PM;1.1m**

Advisory

- Moderate to rough conditions are expected with a significant wave height of 0.9m – 1.5m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
- Light breeze to Fresh breeze of (06-19 knots) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

2.0 – 2.9 m (\approx 6.0 – 8.7 ft)	Moderate-Rough	Caution on operating marine activities
3.0 – 4.0 m (\approx 9.0 – 12.0 ft)	Rough	Warning in place!!!!
4.1 – 5.5 m (\approx 12.3 – 16.5 ft)	Very Rough	Warning in place and marine activities on hold

KEY ON SEA STATE

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	< 1 – 7 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7 – 17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 – \geq 34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!
