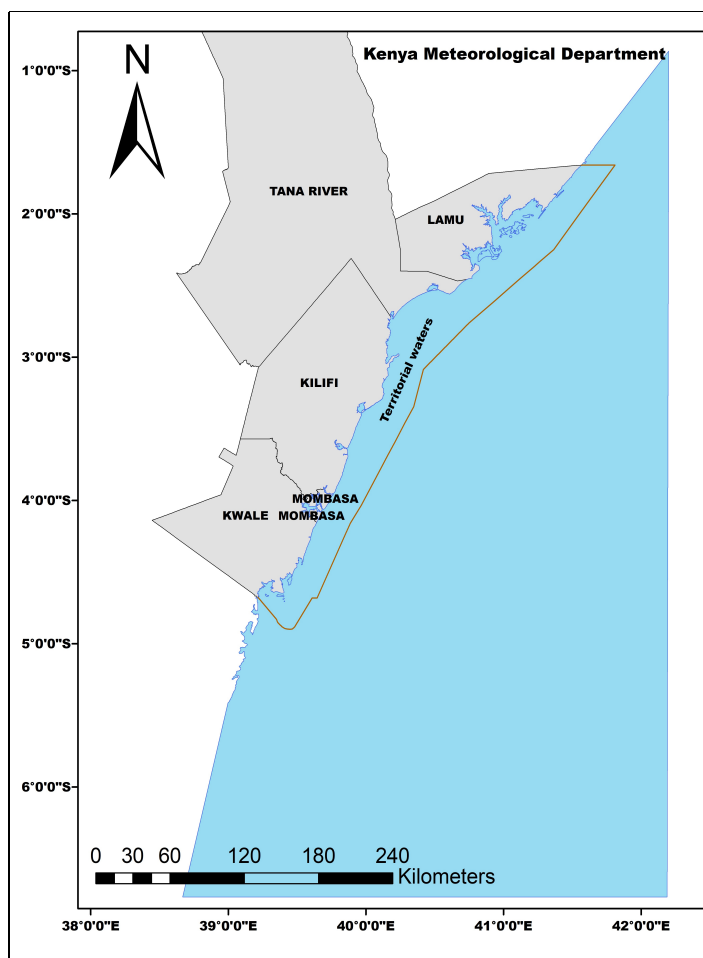

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**DAILY MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST FOR KENYAN COAST**

**Issued at: 1500 EAT on 7<sup>th</sup> February, 2025**

**Valid: 0000 EAT on 8<sup>th</sup> February 2025 to 0000 EAT on 9<sup>th</sup> February 2025**



**GENERAL OUTLOOK**

**Morning sea state:**

- Light and variable winds (01-03 knots) with slight choppy seas. ESE waves of 3-4 feet (1.2m -1.5m) with small period waves of (9 sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

**Afternoon sea state:**

- Light E to SE winds (10-16 knots) with slight choppy seas. ESE waves of 3 feet (0.9m) with small period waves of (9 sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

**Visibility:**

- Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

### **i. KWALE**

- Afternoon sea state: Breezy ESE winds with moderate choppy seas. Very small short period waves.
- Sunrise; **5:57AM** and sunset; **6:17PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10 km)**
- High Tide: **01:30PM; 2.1m,**
- Low Tide: **07:28AM; 1.3m, 06:59PM; 1.3m**

### **iii. KILIFI**

- Morning Winds: WSW 2 knots.
- Morning Waves: ENE 4 feet at 9 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Small short period waves..
- Afternoon Winds: E 12 to 14 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 3 feet at 9 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy E winds with moderate choppy seas. Small short period waves.
- Sunrise; **5:57AM** and sunset; **6:15PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **01:31PM; 1.9m,**
- Low Tide; **07:27AM; 1.0m, 06:59PM;1.1m**

### **iv. LAMU**

- Morning Winds: SW 1 knots.
- Morning Waves: E 3 feet at 9 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: ESE 10 to 15 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 3 feet at 9 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy ESE winds with moderate choppy seas. Very small short period waves.
- Sunrise; **00:38AM** and sunset; **6:10PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **01:31 PM; .1.8m,**
- Low Tide: **07:30 AM; 1.0m, 06:57 PM;1.1m**

### Advisory

- Moderate to rough conditions are expected with a significant wave height of 0.9m – 1.2m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
- Light breeze to Fresh breeze of (01-16 knots) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

#### KEY ON SEA STATE

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	< 1 – 7 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7 – 17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 – $\geq$ 34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!
