# MOMBASA COUNTY WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST VALID 18<sup>TH</sup> – 24<sup>TH</sup> FEB 2025

### PART-I: Mombasa County Weekly Weather Outlook

- 1 Dry weather conditions are expected throughout the forecast week. Slight to moderate showers expected towards the end of the forecast week.
- 2 The expected range of daytime MAXIMUM temperature is 31- 32 °C; the average MINIMUM temperature will be around 26 °C.
- 3. Wind strength will vary between 5 8 m/s (10 16 Kt) throughout the forecast period.
- 4. Moderate Ocean conditions throughout the forecast week. Ocean conditions (1.4 2.0 m).





## PRECIPITATION DISTRIBUTION OVER MOMBASA COUNTY 18 – 24 FEB 2025



## 10 DAYS FORECASTS FOR WINDS, PRECIPITATIONS AND TEMPERATURE MOMBASA



#### TEN DAYS SIGNIFICANT WAVE HEIGHTS, WINDS, OVER SOUTH WEST INDIAN OCEAN



The distribution of wind directions is North East, throughout the 10 days forecast period, the wind speeds vary between 4 m/s and 10 m/s, the wave heights vary between 1.2 m and 2.0 m. The wave directions are Northeasterly (NE) and the wave periods between 7 and 8 seconds
