

GENERAL OUTLOOK

Morning sea state:

Light and variable winds (04-14 knots) with slight choppy seas. ESE waves of 4-5 feet (1.2m - 1.5m) with small period waves of (7-12 sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Afternoon sea state:

Light E to SE winds (11-26 knots) with slight choppy seas. ESE waves of 4-6 feet (1.2m - 1.8m) with small period waves of (7 sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Visibility:

 Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

i. KWALE

- Morning Winds: NNW 11 to 13 knots.Morning Waves: ENE 4 feet at 7 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Breezy NNW winds with moderate choppy seas. Small short period waves...
- Afternoon Winds: NE 23 to 26 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 6 feet at 6 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Strong NE winds with very choppy seas. Small Craft Advisory. Moderate very short period waves.
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10 km)
 High Tide: 10.37 AM; 1.9m,
- Low Tide: 04:37AM; 1.6m, 04:02 PM;1.6m

ii. MOMBASA

- Morning Winds: NNW 7 to 9 knots.
- Morning Waves: ENE 4 feet at 7 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light NNW winds with a slight chop. Small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: NE 17 to 20 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 4 feet at 7 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Moderate to strong NE winds with choppy seas. Small short period waves.
- Sunrise; 5:57AM and sunset; 6:17PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10 km)
- High Tide: 10:03AM; 1.9m, 11:33PM; 2.4m,
- Low Tide: 04:33AM; 1.6m, 03:47PM; 1.5m

iii. KILIFI

- Morning Winds: NNW 4 knots.
- Morning Waves: ENE 5 feet at 7 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: ENE 15 to 18 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 5 feet at 7 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy ENE winds with moderate choppy seas. Small short period waves.
- Sunrise; 5:57AM and sunset; 6:15PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10km)
- High Tide: 09:41AM; 1.6m, 11:35PM; 2.1m,
- Low Tide; 04:32AM; 1.4m, 03:22PM;1.4m

iv. LAMU

- Morning Winds: ENE 7 to 14 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 4 feet at 12 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light ENE winds with a slight chop. Small mid period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: E 11 to 15 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: E 4 feet at 7 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy E winds with moderate choppy seas. Small short period waves.
- Sunrise; 00.38AM and sunset; 6:10PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10km)
- High Tide: 09.39 AM; 1.5m, 11.33 PM; 2.1m
- Low Tide: 04:39 AM; 1.3m, 03:15 PM; 1.3m

Advisory

- Moderate to rough conditions are expected with a significant wave height of 1.2m − 1.8m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
- Calm breeze to Strong breeze of (04-26 knots) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu. Small boats and crafts are advised to be cautious while carrying out marine activities around Mombasa and Kwale.

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	<1-7 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7 – 17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 - ≥34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!!
