DAILY WEATHER FORECAST

Issued on 2nd March 2025 at 3.00 P.M. Validity: from 9.00 pm tonight to 9.00 pm tomorrow 3rd March 2025.

PART I: WEATHER OUTLOOK ACROSS THE COUNTRY

Dry weather conditions expected over the country. Maximum temperatures expected to be high (more than 30°C) over most parts of the country except some areas over the Highlands east and west of the Rift Valley where temperatures are expected to be below 30°C. Strong easterly component winds of over 25 knots (12.5 m/s) expected over the Northwestern and Northeastern parts of the country.

THE HIGHLANDS WEST OF THE RIFT VALLEY, THE LAKE VICTORIA BASIN, AND THE RIFT VALLEY

These counties include: KAKAMEGA, VIHIGA, BUSIA, BUNGOMA, KISUMU, KISII, NYAMIRA, MIGORI, SIAYA, HOMABAY, KERICHO, NANDI, BOMET, NAKURU, ELGEYO MARAKWET, WEST POKOT, BARINGO, UASIN GISHU, TRANS-NZOIA and NAROK).

Partly cloudy conditions expected tonight. Sunny intervals expected to prevail the entire day tomorrow.

HIGHLANDS EAST OF THE RIFT VALLEY (INCLUDING NAIROBI COUNTY)

(These counties include: NYERI, MURANGA, KIRINYAGA, EMBU, MERU, KIAMBU, THARAKA NITHI, LAIKIPIA, NYANDARUA and NAIROBI).

Partly cloudy conditions expected tonight. Sunny intervals expected to prevail the entire day tomorrow.

NORTH WESTERN

(These counties include TURKANA and SAMBURU).

Clear sky conditions expected tonight. Sunny conditions expected to prevail the entire day tomorrow. Strong southeasterly winds of over 25 knots (12.5 m/s) expected in Turkana County.

NORTH EASTERN

(These counties include MARSABIT, GARISSA, MANDERA, WAJIR, and ISIOLO).

Partly cloudy conditions expected tonight. Sunny conditions expected to prevail the entire day tomorrow. Strong easterly component winds of over 25 knots (12.5 m/s) expected over the region.

SOUTH EASTERN LOWLANDS

(These counties include: MACHAKOS, MAKUENI, KITUI, TAITA TAVETA, and KAJIADO). Partly cloudy conditions expected tonight. Sunny intervals expected to prevail the entire day tomorrow.

<u>COAST</u>

(These counties include: KWALE, MOMBASA, KILIFI, LAMU, and TANA RIVER). Partly cloudy conditions expected tonight. Sunny intervals expected to prevail the entire day tomorrow.
