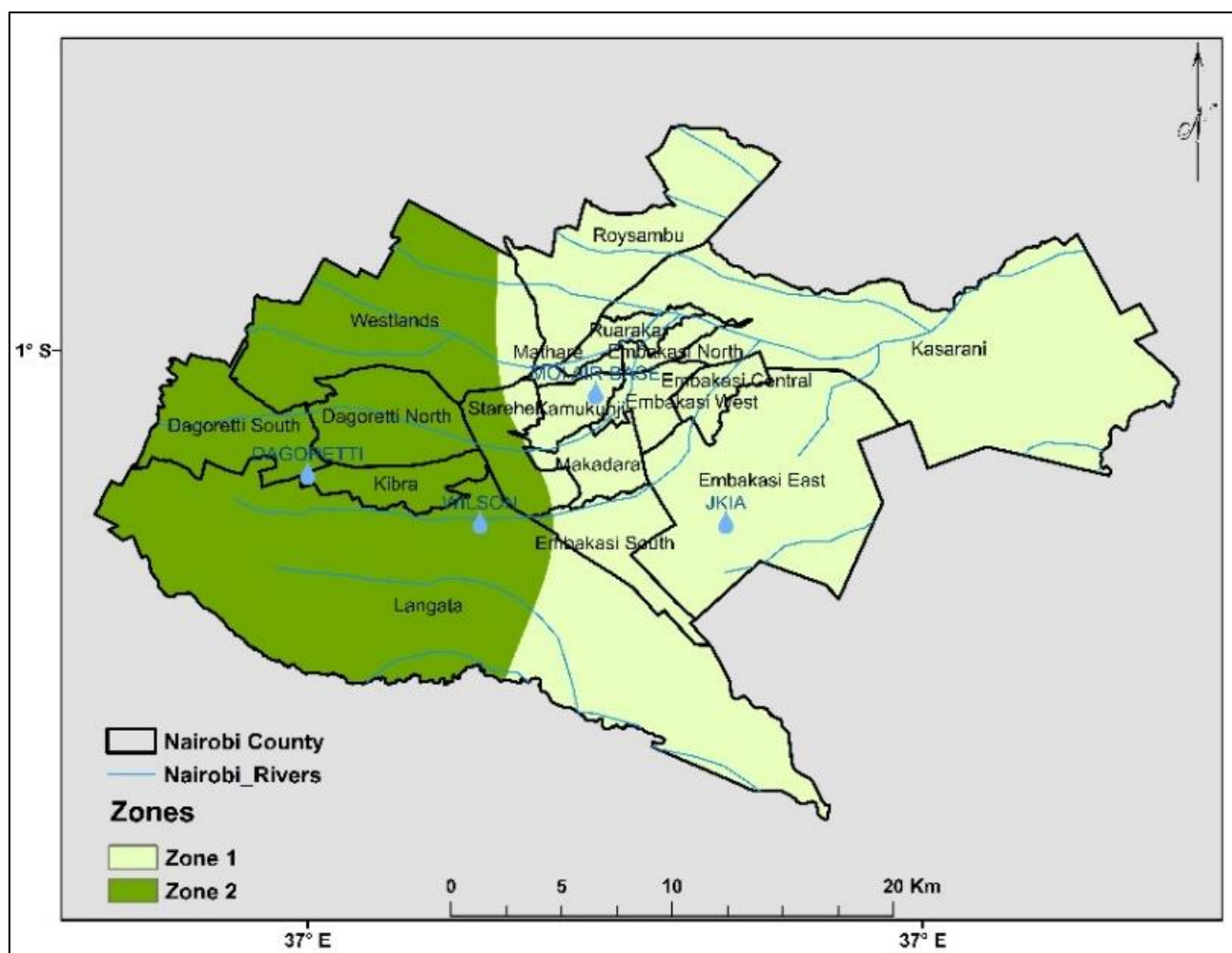







### SUMMARY:

**Colour coding of weather conditions:**

<b>Red</b>	Dangerous and potentially life threatening weather conditions are expected. Take appropriate action immediately to ensure your safety and the safety of your family and neighbours.

**Key for symbols showing spatial rainfall distribution**

Rain likely to fall in few places (&lt;33%)



Rain likely to fall in several places (33-66%)



Rain likely to fall in most places (more than 66%)

**24-hour rainfall categories**

<b>Range</b>	<b>Category</b>
<5 mm	Light
5 - 20mm	Moderate
20 - 50mm	Heavy
>50mm	Very heavy
