

i. <u>KWALE</u>

- Morning Winds: SSW 13 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 5 feet at 10 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Breezy SSW winds with moderate choppy seas. Moderate mid period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: SSW 21 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 6 feet at 10 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Strong SSW winds with very choppy seas. Small Craft Advisory. Moderate mid period waves.

- Afternoon sea state: Strong SSW winds with very choppy seas. Small Craft Advisory. Moderate mid period waves.

- Visibility: Moderate (9-10km)

- Afternoon sea state: Light S winds with a slight chop. Moderate mid period waves.

- Visibility: Moderate (9-10km)
- High Tide: 03.54AM; 2.6m, 04.05PM; 3.5m,

Advisory

- Moderate Rough sea conditions are expected with a significant wave height of 1.5m 2.4m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu. Small boats and crafts are advised to be cautious due to moderate - rough waves expected.
- Light breeze to Strong breeze of (06-22 knots) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
 Small boats and crafts are advised to be cautious while venturing into deep sea due to strong winds expected in the afternoon.

KEY ON SEA STATE

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	< 1 – 7 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7 – 17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 - ≥34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!!
